GETTING HERE

Via the London Underground



The nearest London Underground station is **Kentish Town**, on the Northern Line.

Camden Town Station is served by both Bank and Charring Cross branch trains.

When you exit the station Franco Manca and Café Nero will be in front of you.



Turn left out of the station and make your way straight ahead.



Keep going forwards, passing shops and cafes. You will cross three side roads.



When you see the Job Centre, you have reached Patshull Road, turn left and head down this street.

GETTING HERE

Via London Overground



Kentish Town West

The nearest London Overground Station is Kentish Town West



Exit the station onto Prince of Wales Road, facing a builders merchant called 'Buttle's'

Turn left to walk up the road.



Walk along Prince of Wales road. You'll pass flats and a few business.

Walk for approximately 10 minutes, you don't need to turn but you will cross over a few side roads.



When you reach the junction with Kentish Town Road, you should use the crossing to head to the other side of the road. There is a construction site and a dentist ahead of you.

Once you're over the road, turn left and walk up Kentish Town Road



When you see the Job Centre, you have reached Patshull Road, turn right and head down this street.

GETTING HERE

Via Bus



Bus routes: 88, 134, 214

Coming from south London the stop is Kentish Town Post Office (Stop KE)

Once you get off the bus, walk in the opposite direction down Kentish Town Road and cross it at the next crossing.

Coming from north London the stop is Kentish Town Post Office (Stop KC)

Once you get off the bus walk in the direction of traffic down Kentish Town Road.



You will pass Gaisford Street on your left and the next side road will be Patshull Road.



When you see the Job Centre, you have reached Patshull Road, turn left and head down this street.

GETTING HERE

Via National Rail

ThamesLink/

The closest rail station is Kentish Town Station, which is served by Thameslink trains.

Please note, the London Underground station at Kentish Town is closed from 26th June 2023. The National Rail side of the station will remain open.



Turn left out of the station and make your way straight ahead, walking down Kentish Town Road.



Keep going forwards, passing shops, cafes and other businesses.

You will cross three side roads.



When you see the Job Centre, you have reached Patshull Road, turn left and head down this street.

Accessing the building



On your right, just behind the Job Centre on Patshull Road you will see an alley, Clean Break is located down the alley on the left-hand side.

The alley way is uneven and cobbled, if you require any assistance, please call us on 020 7482 8600.



Make your way down this alley, on the left-hand side you will come to a door, next to a large gate, with a Clean Break sign.

There is an intercom system, with a call point located next to the door.



Press the larger circular button on the intercom panel.

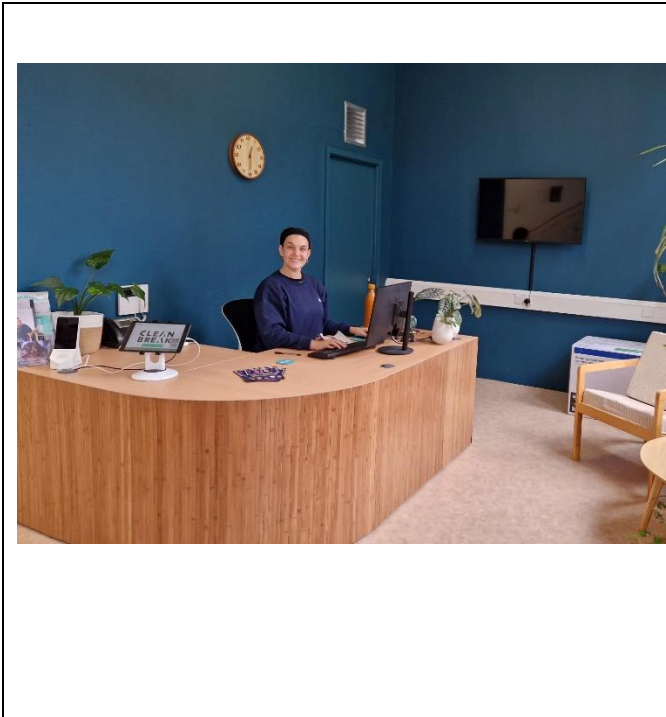
A member of staff will speak to you through the intercom. They will release the door, if you are able to you can then push it open to enter our courtyard.

If you require assistance, one of our team will come out and open the door for you.

Make your way up the path. This turquoise and glass door is the main entrance. It is a pull and opens outwards.

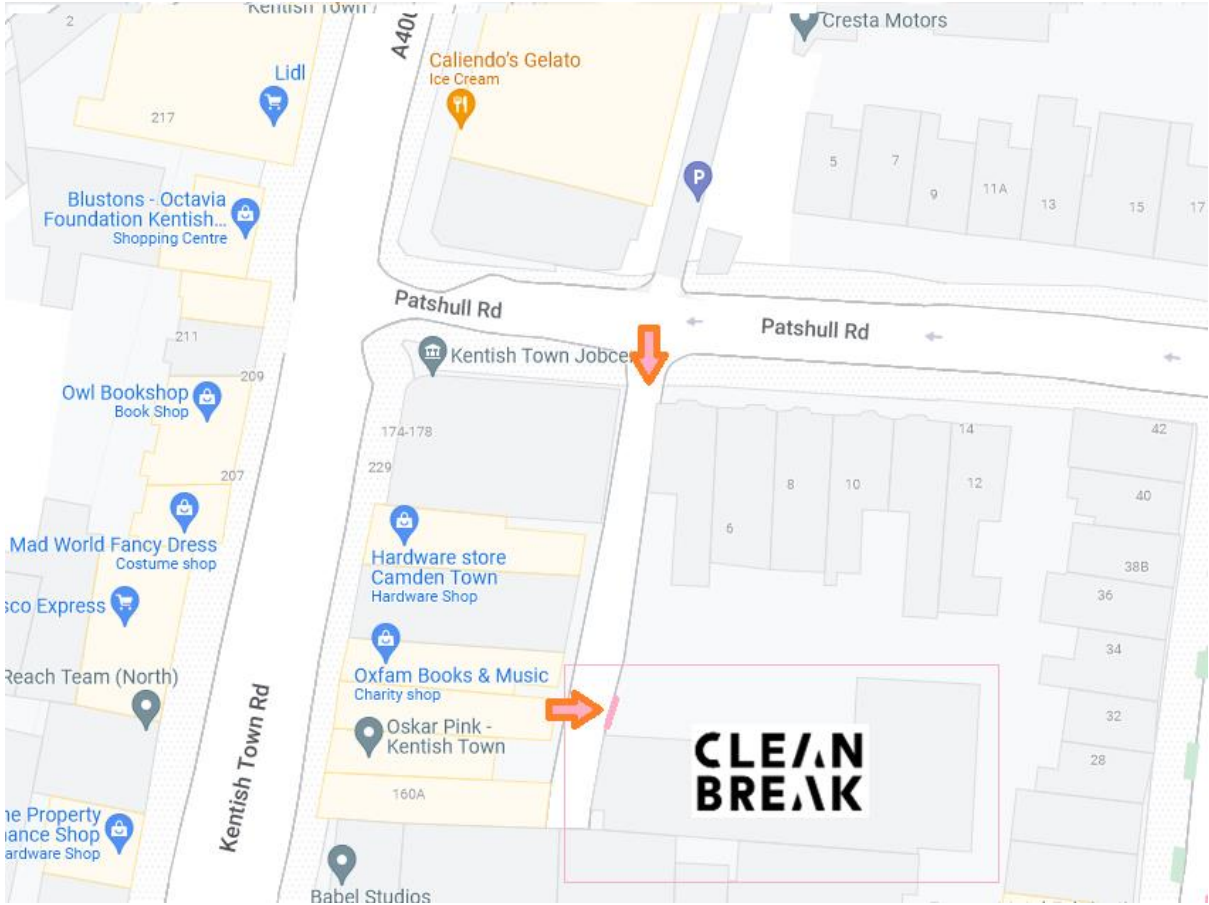


You've arrived.
